NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

- (3) There will be no violation of correlative rights by the granting of said application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD THAT the application of Walter D. Broadhead be granted allowing an exception to the provisions of the Order issued in Cause No. 102-16B so as to permit the drilling of the Federal Cisco No. 5 well located 2040 feet from the North line and 2348 feet from the West line of Section 29, Township 20 South, Range 24 East, SLM, Grand County, Utah.




