ORDER
CAUSE NO. 131-8

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Pursuant to the Order issued on February 19, 1970, this cause came on for hearing before the Board of Oil and Gas Conservation, Department of Natural Resources of the State of Utah, at 10:00 A.M., on Wednesday, June 17, 1970, in the Governor's Board Room, 2nd Floor-State Capitol Building. NOW THEREFORE, the Board having heard the testimony of the witnesses and having considered the evidence and being advised in the premises, now makes and enters the following:

FINDINGS

1. Due and regular notice of the time, place and purpose of the hearing was given to all interested parties in the form and manner and within the time required by law and the rules and regulations of the Board.
2. The Board has jurisdiction over the matter covered by said Application and over all parties interested therein and has jurisdiction to make and promulgate the Order hereinafter set forth.
3. The surface features of the Bluebell Area are such that some exceptions to the well location pattern established by the Order issued in Cause No. 131-6, will be necessary.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Order in Cause No. 131-6, which in part reads:


"...the permitted well for each drilling unit of 640-acres, more or less, shall be located in the center of the SW 1/4 of each of the Sections described in paragraphs 1(c) and 2, above, with a tolerance of 220' in any direction...."

is hereby amended to read:

"...the permitted well for each drilling unit of 640-acres, more or less, shall be located in the center of the SW 1/4 of each of the sections described in paragraphs 1(c) and 2, above, with a tolerance of 220' in any direction, provided that an exception to said tolerance may be granted without a hearing where a topographical exception is deemed necessary...."


