The Board of Oil, Gas and Mining, State of Utah, conducted a hearing on Thursday, May 28, 1981, at 9:00 a.m., in the Wildlife Resources Auditorium, 1596 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah, in the above entitled matter, at which time the Board entered an Order granting an exception to the well location pattern established by the Order issued in Cause No. 139-8, dated September 20, 1972, by authorizing the applicant to drill the Moon No 1-30C4 well in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, USM, Duchesne County, Utah.

At the time this Order was entered, there was a question as to whether the Board was properly constituted. Therefore, a hearing was held on September 24, 1981 to allow a newly constituted Board to reconsider this application.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board having considered this matter, now makes and enters the following:

FINDINGS

1. Due and regular notice of the date, place and purpose of the hearing was given to all interested parties as required by law and the rules and regulations.

2. That no objection to the Order adopted by the Board on May 28, 1981 was made prior to or on the date scheduled for the re-hearing of this matter.

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the Order issued in this Cause on May 28, 1981, is hereby re-affirmed.



NOW THEREFORE, the Board having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits reviewed in said hearing and being fully advised of the premises, now makes and enters the following:

FINDINGS

1. This Board's Order issued in Cause No. 139-8 established drilling units comprising 640 acres, more or less, consisting of each numbered section. Said Section 30, T.3S., R.4W., U.S.M. was one of the sections so designated. That Order further established the permitted location of the drilling of a unit well as being in the center of the NE1/4 of each of said sections with a 660 foot tolerance in any direction from the center of said one-quarter section to be granted administratively for topographical reasons.

2. The Duchesne Municipal Airport occupies the N1/2 and SW1/4 of said Section 30. The Airport, its runways and other facilities, would deny Gulf Oil Corporation access to the permitted location site.

3. Gulf Oil Corporation has applied for and has obtained approval from the Federal Aviation Administration for the drilling of a well in the SE1/4 of said Section 30 on the condition that the well not be located nearer than 2,000 feet from the threshold of the East-West runway or 2,000 feet from the threshold of the South-North runway of said Airport. Such conditions preclude the location of a well at a feasible location within the NE1/4 of said Section 30.

4. Sufficient evidence now being available upon which to reach a decision, the Board issues the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THIS BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

This Board's Order in Cause No. 139-8 establishing the permitted location for a drilling unit well to be in the center of the NE1/4 of a numbered section, is hereby amended to the extent of permitting a drilling unit well to be drilled at the location applied within the following legal subdivision, to wit:

Township 3 South, Range 4 West, U.S.M.

Section 30: SE1/4SE1/4

at a location described as being 669 feet from the East line and 669 feet from the South line of the SE1/4SE1/4 of said Section 30.

5. Said proposed well, the "Moon No. 1-30C4" is hereby designated as the drilling unit well for said Section 30, Township and Range as aforesaid.




