





On August 27, 1956, the following letter was sent to you by this office:

"It has come to the attention of this office that Well No. Stanley 1, which was drilled by you on Section 31, Township 10 North, Range 3 West, Box Elder County, has been completed, plugged and abandoned, or shut down as of about May 26, 1956.

Rule C-5 (a), General Rules and Regulations and Rules of Practice and Procedure, Utah Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, provides that within 90 days after the suspension of operations, abandonment of, or the completion of any well drilled for the production of oil or gas and within 90 days after the completion of any further operations on it, if such operations involved drilling deeper or drilling or re-drilling any formation, the well log shall be filed with the Commission, as well as a copy of the electric and radio-activity logs, if run.

If our information is correct, will you please forward the well log or logs to this office as required by the above mentioned rule. If our information is not correct, will you so notify us."





Memo for Oil + Gas Cons. Commission: ①

Reference is made Adamantia Corp. No. 1
Stanley drilled in NE⁴ NE⁴ Sec 31, T10N, R. 3 W.,
Box Elder Co Utah. Operations on this location
began in March 1956. During the following
2 month a cable tool rig (spudder) was
moved on location and the hole drilled to
a depth of approximately 80' to 100'. At this
time 4 joints of 10" heavy casing was placed
on location.

A field inspection of the operation was
made by the writer on Dec 18, 1956. In company
with the land owner and lessor, Grant H. Nelson,
a rancher living 1/4 mile north of the well,
I observed that 10" casing was run into the
well, top of which casing extends 1 foot above
the ground, open but covered with a bucket.
Water stands in the casing 3 ft from surface

(2)

It is not known by Nelson whether more than one joint of ^{heavy 10"} casing was run into the well, but he believes that all 4 joints (80') were run and welded rather screwed together. After pipe (Casing) was set in well, 5 sacks of cement slurry was dumped around the annulus of the casing, Nelson says, and so appears to be the case. Since the water table in this flat lake bed area stands at 3' below the surface there is little wonder that the hole stands full of water. A well drilled $\frac{1}{2}$ mi distant from this well produces potable water from around 400' depth, the "surface" water at 20' depth having been cased off.

Whether the 10" casing in the Stanley well is pulled or not, my recommendation is that the well be plugged by filling from bottom to

top with heavy mud before operator's
liability under the posted [#] 5,000 bond be
released. (3)
