Gentlemen:

Enclosed please find map showing location of core holes to be drilled by the undersigned in Box Elder County, Utah, Townships 8 and 9 North, Ranges 2 and 3 West, S. L. M.

Bond has been filed with your Commission.

These core holes will be drilled with a wash-rod outfit in order to find the top of the lime in the area being prospected; the top of the lime should be located between 150' and 400' in depth.

Should oil and/or gas be discovered in commercial quantities in any one of the core holes, the undersigned will immediately notify your Commission; in case said core hole discovery does not conform to center of 40 acre tract spacing then the undersigned will plug said core hole and make a new location as near to the center of the 40 acre tract as possible depending upon topography and geological conditions which may control the area.

All core holes will be plugged according to your rules and regulations. Plugging reports will be furnished to you upon completion of said core drilling. Affidavits covering plugging will also be furnished to you so that the Bond may be returned to us in the proper manner.






