





Gentlemen:

Insofar as this office is concerned, approval to drill the above mentioned wells is hereby granted in accordance with the Order in Cause No. 120-1, on February 17, 1966. However, approval is conditional upon receiving a more detailed footage location other than the submitted well location plat.

We are sorry to put you to this inconvenience but, this office is unable to accurately scale the well sites due to the distortion of the plat in the reproduction process. For your convenience it is recommended that you contact Hansen and Associates and ask them to furnish this Commission with the footage location of the wells in reference to the NE Corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 8 N., Range 7 W. As a matter of expedience it is further recommended that not only the above referred to tests be described, but all thirty-five proposed drilling locations which are shown on the plat.





On October 25, 1967, a visit was made to the above named field to determine what new wells have been completed; and what the delay has been in reporting their progress and production to this office.

I met with the new field foreman and driller, Mr. C.B. Morris, who has taken the place of Mr. Jack Wright, Brigham City, Utah; and it appears that the lack of well completion and production reports has been due to poor communications. Mr. Morris was informed of the various rules regarding the hearing that was held for Cause No. 120-1 with respect to one-acre spacing. A map will be furnished to the driller to indicate exactly those wells which he will be drilling in the future, and this will correspond with the field survey plat that is in the Division's files. At the time of the visit, none of the wells were producing, however, they are just shut-in on a temporary basis and will be put back on production next week.

The following is a resume' of the status of existing wells:

- Well # 1 -- Capable of production and is on pump
- Well # 2 -- Capable of production and is on pump
- Well # 3 -- Capable of production and is on pump
- Well # 4 -- Non-productible, temporarily abandoned, pump has been removed.
- Well # 5 -- Capable of production and is on pump
- Well #11 -- Capable of production and is on pump
- Well #12 -- Capable of production and is on pump
- Well #15 -- Capable of production, has a pulling unit over it for cleanout purposes, and is presently oozing a small amount of crude which is being confined in the nearby pit.
- Well #16 -- Capable of production and is on pump
- Well #18 -- Capable of production and is on pump
- Well #24 -- Drilling operations have been completed to a total depth of 238' with the small drilling rig and is in the process of being completed as a producer.

Shipments of the low gravity viscous crude have been made for the months of July, August, September, and October. Although the amount has not been submitted, Mr. Morris assured me that upon receiving the proper forms he would up-date the field's progress. I also informed Mr. Morris that this office would prefer receiving the production reports in barrels rather

than in tons, and it would be necessary for his company to make the proper conversion factor. It should be noted that due to the characteristic of the crude, and the method of handling, it would be impossible for the company to report the amount of water that is produced since it is received at the central storage tank and converted to steam, whereupon it is evaporated into the air. Also, it is impossible to report individual well's oil capacity.

It should be further noted that the Intermountain Asphalt Company in Woods Cross, is the main buyer of the Rozel Point crude; and the manger of the factory is Mr. Keith Weinegar.
