

This letter is to advise you that timely and proper procedures must be taken to insure safety and to protect the property on which the above referenced wells are located. A recent visit to these wells indicates action must be taken by WEM to properly abandon these wells in accordance with Rule D-1, D-2 & D-4 of the State of Utah Oil and Gas Conservation General Rules and Regulations (a copy of these rules, along with several Completion Reports, are included for your information).

Please contact this office and obtain an approved plugging program for each of the wells by the 30th of September 1981, and arrange to commence plugging on or before October 15, 1981. Should this matter go unanswered, you would leave us no other choice than to proceed with an order to show cause why the State should not take action against your bond to complete the work on the wells and locations.


