

Dear Sirs:

The proposed Husky 13-28 Federal which is 239' F.W.L., 1116 F.S.L., Sec. 28, T6S, R7W, does not comply with Utah General Spacing Requirements in Rule C-3 (b).

We would like to apply for an exception to this rule under Rule C-3 (c)(1). The location is in the Ashley National Forest and to meet Forest Service requirements, the well has to be staked at the above location. This will cause the minimum amount of land damage and dirt work. These locations have been inspected by the Forest Service and U.S.G.S. out of Duchesne and Vernal respectively, and environmental studies have been made determining this to be the best location.



In reply to your letter of March 10, this is to advise you that we have not started drilling operations on the above captioned wells. At this time, we do not know when operations will commence but will keep you advised.


