Dear Miss Warner:

In reply to your letter of July 9, 1965 I am sorry to have to report that our files no longer contain the logs concerning the above well which you requested in your letter.

The Fee #1 Well was spudded on July 14, 1954, reached a total depth of 4,603 ft. on August 17, 1954, and was plugged and abandoned on September 16, 1954.

Information in our files indicates that the Ferron sand section extended from a depth of 4,117 ft. to a depth of 4,598 ft.

We are sorry not to be able to provide further information concerning this well. Perhaps Kemmerer Coal Company or Mr. Max L. Krueger will be able to do further.
