

Re: Stipulation

Dear Sir:

Utah Southern Oil Company is the owner of U. S. Oil & Gas Lease #07581, and proposes to drill a well on the leased premises to test for oil and gas at a location in the C N 1/2 NW 1/4, Sec. 34 T18S R7E SLM, Emery County, Utah (688 ft. from the north line, 1314 ft. from the west line)

State Oil & Gas Regulations require that no well be drilled less than 500 ft. from the boundary of any legal subdivision without written consent of the Supervisor, State Oil & Gas Conservation Commission. The proposed location is approximately in the center of the N 1/2 of NW 1/4 of section 34, but is considered necessary because of conditions as follows:

A. It was geologically desirable to locate this well either in C NE NW of Sec. 34, 18S, 7E or C SE SW of Sec. 27, 18S, 7E. Examination of both of these locations indicated it physically impossible to set up a rig on either of these sites due to high hills and deep gullies which comprise the area. Two areas were available to us; 1) an area approximately on the common boundary line of Sec. 27 and Sec. 34 and approximately 1320 ft. from the west line, and 2) the location suggested in this stipulation. Because of easier road construction and approximately 200 ft. lower elevation, the second area was chosen.

B. If further evidence of the necessity to choose this drilling site is required, we invite your representative to contact our company concerning a suitable date to examine the location site.

Therefore, Utah Southern Oil Company, Lessee, requests the consent of the Supervisor to the drilling of a proposed well at the above described location. In consideration of such consent, Utah Southern Oil Company, Lessee, hereby expressly covenants and agrees that it will make no separate assignments of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 34 Township 18S, Range 7E, SLM and that it will keep the above described subdivisions under joint assignment until the above mentioned well has been plugged and abandoned with the approval of the Supervisor.





Gentlemen:

It has come to the attention of this office that Well No. _____, which was drilled by you on Section 3, Twp. 18-S, Range 7-E, Emery County, has been completed, plugged and abandoned, or shut down as of about 8-18-56, 1956.

Rule C-5 (a), General Rules and Regulations and Rules of Practice and Procedure, Utah Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, provides that within 90 days after the suspension of operations, abandonment of, or the completion of any well drilled for the production of oil or gas and within 90 days after the completion of any further operations on it, if such operations involved drilling deeper or drilling or re-drilling any formation, the well log shall be filed with the Commission, as well as a copy of the electric and radioactivity logs, if run.

If our information is correct, will you please forward the well log or logs to this office as required by the above mentioned rule. If our information is not correct, will you so notify us.


