





Supplemental Stipulations

- 1) Adequate and sufficient electric/radioactive logs will be run to locate and identify anticipated coal beds in the Mancos. Please also provide two copies of drilling logs. Casing and cementing programs will be adjusted to eliminate any potential influence of the well bore or productive hydrocarbon zones on the coal resource. Surface casing program may require adjustment for protection of fresh water aquifers.

ADDITIONAL STIPULATIONS FOR PRODUCTION FACILITIES

Your Application for Permit to Drill also included a submittal for production facilities. These production facilities are approved for the lessee and his designated operator under Section 1 of the Oil and Gas Lease with the following conditions:

- (1) The oil and gas measurement facilities must be installed on the well location. The oil and gas meters will be calibrated in place prior to any deliveries. Tests for meter accuracy are to be conducted monthly for the first three months on new meter installations and at least quarterly thereafter. Please provide this office with a date and time for the initial meter calibration and all future meter proving schedules. A copy of the meter calibration reports are to be submitted to the Salt Lake City District Oil and Gas Supervisor. Royalty payments will be made on all production volume as determined by the meter measurements or the tank measurements. All measurement facilities must conform with the API standards for liquid hydrocarbons and the AGA standard for natural gas measurement.
- (2) Gas meter runs for each well will be located within 500 feet of the wellhead. The gas flowline will be buried from the wellhead to the meter and 500 feet downstream of the meter run or any production facilities. Meter runs must be housed and/or fenced.
- (3) All disturbed areas not required for operations will be rehabilitated.
- (4) All produced liquids must be contained including the dehydrator vent/condensate line effluent. All production pits must be fenced.
- (5) The well activity, the well status and the date the well is placed on production must be reported on Lessee's Monthly Report of Operations, Form 9-329.
- (6) All off-lease storage, off-lease measurement, or commingling on lease or off-lease must have written approval.
- (7) All product lines entering and leaving hydrocarbon storage tanks must be locked/sealed.
- (8) You are reminded of the requirements for handling, storing, or disposing of water produced from oil and gas wells under NTL-2B.
- (9) All materials, trash, junk, debris, etc. not required for production must be removed from the well site and production facility site at the completion of these operations.
- (10) A copy of the Gas Sales Contract will be provided to this office and the Royalty Accounting Department as directed.
- (11) Construction and maintenance for surface use approved under this plan should be in accordance with the surface use standards as set forth in the BLM/GS Oil and Gas Brochure entitled, "Surface Operating Standards for Oil and Gas Exploration and Development." This includes, but is not limited to, such items as road construction and maintenance, handling of top soil and rehabilitation.
- (12) "Sundry Notice and Reports on Wells" (form 9-331) will be filed for all changes of plans and other operations in accordance with 30 CFR 221.58. Emergency approval may be obtained verbally, but such approval does not waive the written report requirement. Any additional construction, reconstruction, or alternations of facilities, including roads, gathering lines, batteries, measurement facilities, etc., will require the filing of a suitable plan and prior approval by the survey.

6. Drilling Program:

- A. Air will be used as drilling medium from surface to 2000' and from 3385' or intermediate casing depth to TD of 3960'. A foaming agent will be used as necessary should water be encountered.

7. Auxiliary Control Equipment:

- A. Kelly cocks will be used.
- B. A full opening safety valve with drill pipe threads, in the open position, will be on the rig floor at all times.
- C. A bit float will not be used unless conditions dictate.

8. Testing, Coring and Logging Programs:

- A. Drill stem tests.

Moenkopi if warranted.

- B. Cores.

None anticipated.

- C. Logs.

Compensated Neutron-Formation Density. 500' ± to TD.
Gamma Ray will be run from surface to TD.

9. No abnormal pressures temperatures or hazards are anticipated.
10. It is anticipated that drilling operations will commence August 1, 1983, with approximately 18 days of drilling and coring to reach TD. Completion operations will require an additional 15-30 days.

1. Existing Roads - Exhibits "A" and "B"

- A. Topo Maps "A" and "B" show the well site as staked and its position relative to existing towns, roads and topography.
- B. To reach drill site, turn south off U. S. Route 6, approximately 6.1 miles east of Wellington Park on Farnham Dome Road. Go across cattle guard and take Farnham Dome Road to the south for approximately 7.5 miles to D&RG crossing. Then travel approximately 4.6 miles east and turn to the right on an improved road and travel .3 miles south to Skyline Oil Company's Federal #11-33 well. An access road will pass on east side of well site of Federal #11-33 approximately 0.2 miles to the east.
- C. Existing and proposed roads are shown on Exhibits "A" and "B".
- D. The county roads are maintained and are considered all weather roads.
- E. Maintenance to existing roads will be maintained. Grading and watering down will be done when necessary.

2. Planned Access Road - Exhibit "B"

Access road will be 16' wide and approximately 1200' long with one turnout planned. No major cut or fill is required. If a permanent road is required, surface will be elevated, crowned, ditched and drainage installed as needed. Gravel will be used as surfacing material. One cattleguard will be installed at fence if necessary.

3. Location of Existing Wells - Exhibit "B"

All existing wells and our proposed wells within a two-mile radius of proposed location are shown on Exhibit "B".

4. Location of Existing and/or Proposed Facilities - Exhibit "B"

- A. Lessee has existing facilities within a one-mile radius of the proposed location as shown on Exhibit "B". They are production facilities at Fed. #11-33, Fed. #11-13, Fed. #11-11, Fed. #12-13, Fed. #13-11, Fed. #11-41, Fed. #11-42, Fed. #14-11, Fed. #14-31 and Fed. #12-33.

- B. The proposed production layout for this well is detailed in Exhibit "D" at a 1" = 50' scale. Production and mud pits will be fenced with top flagging over production pit. Three 500 barrel tanks will be placed inside a 40' x 20' x 4.5' retaining wall to prevent contamination in the unlikely event of a tank rupture. This retaining wall will be fenced. Flow lines will be buried and have a working pressure greater than the pressure to be applied.

5. Location and Type of Water Supply

Water is to be hauled from Price River Water Improvement District where it is purchased. Application to the State for water permit has been received. The water will be hauled from Price some 24 miles north and west of site and on State and County roads.

6. Source of Construction Materials

- A. No outside construction materials will be required during drilling operations other than gravel. Gravel purchased or obtained from an approved source will be used in making the well site and access road serviceable under all weather conditions.
- B. Materials will not be obtained from Federal or Indian lands.
- C. No access road will be needed other than that leading from the county road to the drill site as shown on Exhibits "A" and "B".

7. Methods of Waste Disposal

- A. All waste material created by drilling operations, garbage, and trash will be placed in trash containers and is to be collected daily and hauled to the Carbon County land fill or a private land fill. Containers will be built or fenced with small mesh wire to prevent wind from scattering debris. Other waste material -- cuttings, water, drilling fluids, etc. -- created by drilling operations will be placed in mud pit and pit will be fenced at rig moveout. Fluids produced while completing well will be stored in tanks or mud pit as material dictates.
- B. When sufficient time has lapsed for liquid wastes in pits to dry, they will be backfilled as close to original contour as practicable, topsoil spread and re-seeded as per Bureau of Land Management Requirements.
- C. Sewage disposal will be by means of self-contained chemical toilets.

D. Provisions for excess water produced from the well will be established.

8. Ancillary Facilities

None.

9. Well Site Layout - Exhibit "E"

Exhibit "E" shows the well site plan and cross-sections showing amount of cut and fill required. Mud pits will be in at least 4' of cut material. Embankments will be placed in lifts and composted.

10. Plans for Restoration of Surface

- A. Unused surface will be restored to its present condition and contour as nearly as is practicable, with all waste materials buried or burned (with proper permits) and with all pits filled.
- B. All disturbed lands will be covered by stockpiled top soil and re-seeded according to the season and to Bureau of Land Management instructions.
- C. At the time of rig release, all pits will be fenced and so maintained until pits are back-filled.
- D. Any oil on pits will be removed and pits will be overhead flagged.
- E. Rehabilitation will begin as soon as practicable after rig move out and will be completed when pits have dried and the season allows re-seeding.

11. Other Information

- A. The location and road will be along areas consisting of rock and wash material. Most of the area to be disturbed has little soil development. There are no trees in the area to be disturbed.
- B. Vegetation includes sagebrush, locoweed and a few native grasses. Fauna consists of antelope, rabbits, ground squirrels, lizards of various types not exceeding 12 inches in length, and assorted flying and crawling insects.
- C. Grazing is the only surface use activity in the immediate area of the location.
- D. No dwellings of any kind exist in the area and no archeological, historical or cultural sites are apparently

present. An archeological inspection report is included as Exhibit "I".

- E. The leasehold acreage is Federal with surface administered by the Bureau of Land Management. The well is located on Lease U-43778 with Skyline Oil Company, Operator, conducting operations under Designation of Operator from B. K. Seeley, Jr., lessee of record. The well site access road traverses only land under Lease U-43778.
- F. Surface disturbance and vehicular travel will be limited to the approved location and approved access route.
- G. If subsurface cultural or paleontological material is exposed during construction, work will stop immediately and the Price River Resource Area office contacted.
- H. The BLM representative (Mr. Dan Cressy, 801-637-4584) will be notified 48 hours prior to initiation of any surface disturbance associated with a new access road or drilling pad location.
- I. Upon completion of drilling operations, the BLM's representative will be notified of production and/or restoration plans.
- J. Any production facilities will be painted a single, low gloss, pastel color that blends in with the surrounding soil, rock, and/or vegetation. Color will be approved by the BLM prior to application.



Grassy Trail Federal #11-43




Cross Section at Drill Site






FIG. 3.A.1

The on-site inspection for subject wells was conducted in response to a notice of staking. The APD is recommended for approval subject to the following stipulations:

1. ~~████~~ shall insure that all individuals working at or near the location are aware of and comply with all applicable stipulations.
2. The BLM's representative (Sid Vogelpohl, 801-673-4584) will be notified at least 48 hours prior to any surface disturbing activities associated with new access roads or drill pad location. A pre-construction on-site shall be arranged by ~~████~~ at which representatives of the BLM, ~~████~~ and the dirt contractor shall be present.
3. Roads shall be constructed where flagging was located during the on-site inspection. Driving surface widths of the road is to be limited to 16 feet with turnouts at least every 1,000 feet or less as determined by terrain. Roads will be crowned and ditched or sloped with water bars and water turnouts where feasible, if the well is a producer. (Refer to BLM/USGS Surface Operating Standards, figures 1 through 7). Changes in finished road design may be required by the BLM.
4. Six to 8 inches of topsoil on the entire pad site or all available topsoil shall be removed and stockpiled in a manner to minimize soil loss to wind and water erosion. Stockpiles shall be rounded off and located so that soil is not contaminated or compacted. In the event that the well is a producer, soil stockpiles shall be seeded. A seed mix will be provided by the BLM.
5. Vegetative clearing shall be confined to the limits of actual construction. Larger vegetative debris shall be manually scattered at least 15 feet outside the limits of construction.
6. Littering of access roads or pad area by personnel involved in the drilling operation or construction shall be prevented or corrected by ~~████~~. Litter pickup along access roads or in the pad area may be required. Collected garbage and trash will be disposed of at an authorized landfill. Drained equipment oil will be disposed of in pits at drill sites or at a landfill. *Sanitation facilities will be provided as required by the state of Utah.*

7. The completed road used for a producing well shall be maintained so that the travel surface is free of excessive ruts, holes, soft spots, slides and washboards. The road, drainages and shoulders shall be free of large rocks, vegetative debris and slides. Drainage ditches shall be relatively free of sediments and not excessively eroded. Low water crossings shall be maintained.
8. During periods of weather when activity would result in deep rutting (6 inches or more) of the driving surface or excessive disturbance on the right-of-way, a stop work order may be verbally issued by the Authorized Officer with a follow-up written order. An authorization to resume work will be required.
9. Residues and contaminated earth in mud pits may be required to be completely removed if, with reclamation, same would be near to exposed at the surface.
10. Upon completion of drilling operations, the BLM's representative shall be notified by ~~the~~ of production and/or reclamation plans so that an inspection may be conducted to determine if mitigating measures in addition to those included in the surface use plan or presented hereby are necessary.
11. Any production facilities will be painted a single, low gloss, pastel color that will blend with the color of soils, rock or vegetation. Color will be approved by the BLM's representative.
12. Reclamation, when determined necessary by the BLM, will return all disturbed areas to a color and topographic form that blends with the surroundings. Any topsoil stockpiled will be redistributed and the area seeded as specified by the BLM at the time of reclamation. Erosion control devices will be required as determined by the BLM.

The well site is 663 ft. from east line and 1,801 ft. from the south line (NE/SE Quarter), Section II, Township 16 south, Range 12 east, Salt Lake Meridian in Emery County, Utah. See Exhibit 1.

During the morning of November 29, 1983 in Emery County, Utah, a Texas Eastern Developments, Inc. crew was working at a drilling rig referred to as rig #1. The crew was "Fishing" (Lost Drill Stem) which was approximately 3,910 feet deep with installed casing of approximately 3,400 feet. The rig was in a drilling phase for Skyline Oil Company, a division of Texas Eastern's Exploration and Production Group.

During the drilling of this well, occasional pockets of crude oil, gravity 38-40, would surface. This crude would flow through a line referred to as a Blue line into a gas/oil separator and empty into an open steel tank. When the tank was filled, the crude would be transferred by a centrifugal pump powered by a Detroit diesel engine into storage tanks referred to as frac tanks. When the frac tanks were filled, the crude would be removed from the site by the use of vacuum trucks.

At the time of the accident, employees at the site were working at various locations related to their classification. Mr. Dugdale came down from the derrick to check oil levels in the separator pit and the frac tanks. He was somewhere in this area when the fire and explosion occurred.

When the other employees heard the explosion and saw the fire near the frac tanks, they immediately shut-in the well. They saw Mr. Dugdale on fire and various employees ran to help him and attempted to extinguish the fire. Upon realizing that he was dead, they moved back away from the tanks.
See Exhibit 3 and 4.

*Age

Randy Shelton, tool pusher, got in his vehicle and drove to Wellington, Utah approximately ten (10) miles away and called the fire department. The Carbon County Sheriff, Fire and Ambulance Departments responded as follows:


Received call at 4:06 a.m. See Exhibit 5. Fire department arrived at the scene at 4:52 a.m. Extinguished the fire at 5:19 a.m. East Carbon County Fire Department arrived at scene at 5:35 a.m. Wellington Fire Department received the call at 4:03 a.m., but did not arrive at the scene. When the Sheriff of Carbon County realized that the drill site was Emery County, he notified the Emery County Sheriff's Department at 4:20 a.m. See Exhibit 6. Detective Max Thomas and an Identification Officer, Shane Potter, of the Emery County Sheriff's Office responded to the call. See Exhibit 7.

Charles G. Cornelius field safety manager, and C. A. Miller, senior safety supervisor, were notified at 6 a.m., November 29, of the accident by Dale Garner, Manager of Drilling and Production and C. E. Kuykendall, Drilling and Production Superintendent.

Mr. Cornelius notified the Industrial Commission of Utah, required by law, at 9:38 a.m. mountain time. A meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, November 30 at 9 a.m. See Exhibit 8.

Mr. Cornelius and Mr. Miller proceeded to the scene of the accident and arrived at approximately 2:30 p.m. Their investigation revealed that an explosion and fire had occurred in the area of the ground pit, frac tanks, and transfer pump. They found extensive damage to one of the frac tanks, the engine on the circulating pump and some minor damage to three (3) more of the tanks and to the mud pump.

The six (6) frac tanks on the site were of a trailer type - 35' long, 7' 6" wide and 12' 2" high on the wheel end and 9' 10" high on the hitch end. The capacity of each tank is 500 bbls. The tanks were placed on the site through a lease agreement with Skyline Oil Company, 2000 University Club Building, Salt Lake City, Utah, 84111. The tanks are owned by CRC B1-Co Rental, Inc. with locations in Fruita and Rangely, Colorado and Evanston, Wyoming. The manufacturer is Sandmaster. See Exhibit 9.







Dear Mr. Ahmad:

Integrated submitted proposals to horizontally re-complete two wells on lease UTU43778 in the Grassy Trail Field. One well, no. 11-43 is located in section 11, the other well, no. 12-13 is located in section 12. Both proposals were approved by this office on December 27, 2007.

Well no. 12-13 was re-completed horizontally, with a lateral leg that crosses from section 12 into section 11. As a result of the horizontal completion crossing into two sections, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining notified Integrated of their intention of create two Temporary Horizontal Spacing Units covering both sections 11 and 12. Because well no. 12-13 is horizontally completed in section 11, no additional horizontal wells would be permissible under the prevailing well spacing arrangement.

Therefore, the approval to horizontally re-complete well no. 11-43 is rescinded, and your sundry notice request (dated January 7, 2008) to amend the proposed bottom-hole location is being returned unapproved.






