Prior to spudding in this well you must furnish this office a letter consenting to the drilling of this well from each lessee within 660 feet of the proposed location. Without said letter or letters approval to drill this well cannot be granted.

The Order issued in Cause #2, on June 28, 1956, provided for 10 acre spacing in this area. However, approval to drill this well on an unorthodox location was granted due to a 400' highway right of way running through the Quarter Quarter Quarter section.


