

Dear Mr. McCoy:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of November 7, 1958.

On August 5, 1958, permission was granted to R & J Exploration for Consolidated Gold Uranium Corporation to drill Well No. Kimberly 1, 660 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 21 East, S1EM, Grand County, Utah. A bond was, also, filed by the Consolidated Gold Uranium as principal, with the Indemnity Insurance Company of North America as surety in the amount of \$5,000.00.

Approval to drill the above mentioned well was granted on condition that said well be spudded in within 90 days from the date of approval. If this well has not as yet been spudded in, approval to drill has expired as of November 8, 1958.

Before we can release Consolidated Gold Uranium from liability under the bond it will be necessary for said company to file an affidavit to the effect that this well was never spudded in. If the well was spudded in, it will be necessary for our petroleum engineer to inspect the well site.
