
Dear Mr. Feight:



Dear Mr. Feight:

Enclosed is a copy of the land survey to accompany our application to drill a well in Grand County, Utah, which application was dated June 26, 1962. Also enclosed are the revised application showing a new location and a survey on the new location. I am also enclosing a copy of our monthly report of operations to the USGS for your information.

I would like to reiterate to you our reasons for changing the location on this well. As you know, we first became involved in this lease on June 25th at which time we learned that it would be necessary to drill a well on Lease No. U-06970 by June 30th in order to validate the lease. Based on the information we had at that time, we made our original application which requested permission to drill a hole in the NE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 1. At the same time this application was made, we were also making arrangements with Mr. John Osmund, a consulting geologist in Salt Lake, to make a final verification of the location by an actual field survey. It was not possible for Mr. Osmund and me to get on the location until Thursday, June 28th. We reached the proposed site at about 4:00 p.m. on June 28th. Mr. Osmund felt that the dip of the formation at the proposed site, which was four degrees, indicated that it was not as favorable a location as would be found in the NW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 1, near where the dip was approximately sixteen degrees. Mr. Osmund pointed out that the Dakota sands had been tested several times in the immediate area and had always shown water. He, therefore, felt that the Mancos shale was the logical objective in this lease and that the sixteen degree dip was an indication of a better likelihood of finding a fracture in the shale. For this reason, we felt that we should move the location to the NW/4 of the SW/4.

Mr. Osmund and I began pacing from the original well location to the proposed new location. We found that we were not able to reach the center of the NW/4 of the SW/4 due to a steep cliff which drops off approximately fifty feet west of the location which we finally proposed. We did not actually determine the exact location of the center of that quarter section although it would be either at the bottom of the cliff or somewhere on its face. For this reason, we selected the location 1,980 feet from the south line and 1,110 feet from the west line of Section 1. We felt on the basis of the information we had available to us this would be the closest we could come, taking into consideration the time available to us and the topography of the location which we would prefer having.

The following day, Friday morning, we telephoned our office in Salt Lake, asking them to contact your office and that of Don Russell to attempt to obtain approval for the new location. Friday afternoon Mr. Robins of our office advised me that Mr. Russell had verbally approved the change but that your office was unable to do so under the present regulations. My conversations with you in the past had led me to believe that approval could be obtained by making application for it so we decided to spud in on June 30th and rely on our ability to work with you in obtaining approval for the new site.

The well was spudded in Saturday, June 30th, and the rig was working on the well at midnight June 30th. Because we were not sure how long approval from your office would take, we released the driller on July 2nd. It is our intention when approval is obtained to re-enter the site and complete drilling the well.


In view of the information above, it is requested that your office take the necessary steps to grant us approval for the nonconforming location.

I appreciate having had the opportunity of working with you on this project and would like to express my appreciation to you for your cooperation in helping Uinta Oil make preparations for drilling its first well. I hope that in the future these projects will run more smoothly as we learn the procedures involved.



Enclosed is a copy of the resignation as Operator of the Uinta Oil Refining Company submitted to the Bureau of Land Management today.

It is our understanding that Metoil, Incorporated of 161 South First West, Salt Lake City, Utah, has expressed an interest in succeeding Uinta as Operator. It appears that the remaining interest owners are now at liberty to appoint Metoil, Inc., or any qualified operator. Uinta will cooperate fully with you in this regard.

Uinta does not consider that the purported assignment from Great Western Drilling Company to Uinta Oil was valid because of the reasons set forth in correspondence, copies of which you have received, yet Uinta Oil did everything necessary and at considerable expense to protect your interest in all three of the leases involved.

For your information, the annual rentals were paid on State Lease No. 4635 by Uinta for one year on July 1, 1962. A well was spudded on Federal Lease No. U-06970 on June 30, 1962, by Uinta Oil, though it was not completed. As you know, Federal Lease No. U-06748 was declared commercial by the USGS in April, 1962.

Active drilling or reworking or both on the federal leases may be required within a reasonable time in order to hold them.




