Dear Sir:

Our records show that you are the holder of the above oil and gas permit, on which there is an old well drilled prior to the Leasing Act of 1920.

The Department of the Interior has ruled that the permittee is responsible for all oil and gas prospecting operations conducted on the permit.

The above well was mentioned in U. S. Geological Survey Bulletin 541-D "Oil and Gas Near Green River, Utah" based on field work done in 1912 and 1913. Otherwise, this office has little information regarding the well. We are anxious to compile a history of all drilling activities in Utah, both on Government and other lands. It is also necessary for us to have information regarding these wells in disposing of extensions, cancellations and other matters pertaining to permits.

If you are acquainted with the above well on your permit we would appreciate receiving a supplementary history of the well in triplicate on the enclosed forms.

The following are suggestions as to the information to be given on this report: Location of well as near as known, field, county, township and range, quarter-quarter section or feet distant from any line or corner of the surveys; elevation; geological formations at surface and encountered in well; by whom drilled and dates of drilling; total depth; oil, gas and water sands encountered, including thickness and depth; lengths and sizes of casing set and casing left in well at present; water shut-offs; present condition of the well; plugging data; and future plans, if any. All this information may not be obtainable regarding these old wells, but the report should be as complete as possible. A log should also be submitted if available. All information is confidential and not for publication.

If you contemplate further drilling on this permit, a notice of intention to drill should be submitted in accordance with the regulations. This office will be glad to assist you in any way possible and will furnish you a copy of the Operating Regulations or other information you may desire at any time. Please feel free to write or call for any further information or instructions.
