A Mr. Roy Cook, sometime before this Commission was established, drilled a well in Section 24, Township 21 South, Range 23 East, SLBM, Grand County, Utah. Insofar as we have been able to determine, the well is a shut-in gas well. As such, an identification sign should be placed thereon in accordance with our rules and regulations. Mr. Cook has been requested, without avail, to erect an identification sign.

On August 16, 1961, Mr. Cook came into the office and stated that he would either erect an identification sign or plug the well. To date the well has neither been plugged nor identified.

Would you please write Mr. Cook at Woodside, Utah, and inform him that legal action will be taken if the identification sign is not erected. In the alternative, should he desire to plug the well, the plugging program must be approved by this office.

In reference to your letter of January 29, 1962, concerning the jurisdiction of the State Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, please be advised that 40-6-11, U.C.A. 1953, provides that the Oil and Gas Conservation Act applies to all lands in the State of Utah lawfully subject to its police power.

The Utah Supreme Court has indicated, as have a substantial number of other courts, including the United States Supreme Court, that private lands are subject to the police power regulations of the state. 40-6-5, U.C.A. 1953, makes provision for the Commission to order wells plugged or other safety devices installed.

In your letter of January 29th, you indicate that the well was never a producing well and is completely dry. On August 16, 1961, you went to the offices of the State Oil and Gas Conservation Commission and indicated you would plug the subject well sometime in October. In response to a letter dated April 18, 1960, from the State Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, you stated that your well was a shut-in gas well. Our Engineer also informed us that a control head is presently on the well. It would appear then that there is some inconsistency between your present statement that the well is dry and your previous statements and past actions.

However, we will accord you the benefit of the doubt if, not later than February 15, 1962, a sworn affidavit is filed with the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, indicating that the well is not a shut-in gas well and is a dry hole.

If, however, the well is a shut-in gas well, or contains water, you must plug that well, or identify it by proper sign markings not later than February 15, 1962. The fact that the well is located on your private land does not relieve you from the responsibility of taking appropriate safety measures.

If the affidavit or other substantial information is presented to the Conservation Commission which shows that the subject well is in fact a dry hole, there will be no need for you to take any action to plug or identify the well. However, since you had previously indicated that the well was a shut-in gas well, the Commission had no alternative but to ask that you comply with proper regulatory measures.

All wells previously listed under N0000/Unknown Operator on Fee and State leases, have been changed back to the last known operator, based on information obtained from the well files. Wells that are currently in Shut-In, OPS, or TA status have been assigned Entity numbers. Bond availability has been reviewed for wells on Fee land. Operator's with unplugged wells will now show up on the monthly turnaround report under the last known operator, except for those wells with TA or OPS status. However, due to the fact that the majority of these operators no longer exist, and the fact that the wells have been in unknown operator status for several years, the operator's addresses have been X'd out to prevent mailing of the monthly report.

My intentions are to follow-up with St. Lands/Ed Bonner on lease cancellations, assignments & bonding for wells drilled on State leases.
