





COMMENT:

Minor shale gas noted in Mancos, with first blow at 248'.
Minor water noted at 541'-543' at top of Dakota. This is only water encountered and it has been necessary to haul essentially all drilling water.

We had planned to pull the 7" casing on this well and run 5 1/2" casing from surface to 816' and cement back to above the Dakota. A report of intention to so do was typed on April 11, 1961, but mislaid in our office and not delivered to you, until April 21, 1961. Caving below the foot of the 7" at 661' forced an immediate field change of plan to save the hole and the 7" was cemented at 661' with 50 sacks, calculated to fill the annulus well above the top of the Dakota at 541'. Hole was then cleaned out to the top of the sand at 820' and two sacks of quick set spotted at 820' to protect the sand. The 5 1/2" string was then landed at 816' and cemented with 10 sacks.

PROPOSAL:

We now propose to drill through the sand and complete open hole in the sand, as indicated and will so report to you in accordance.




