Survey plats will be delivered to your office by surveyor. We propose to drill this well to an approximate total depth of 10,200' in the Morrison formation. BOP's will be installed and checked frequently. Tertiary tar sands will be cored if encountered. Electric logs will be run to total depth. Open hole and conventional drill stem tests will be run as warranted. Hole will be drilled with air or mist whenever possible. Intermediate casing will be set at the top of the Mancos. If a producing well is indicated, production casing will be set through the pay section and selectively perforated; fracing or acidizing may be necessary to stimulate production.

Survey Plat + Check for spacing to close to country Stab #1 sec. 5 + Recommend men, distribute to the environment - located in same property as Cedar Camp Ridge.

Insofar as this office is concerned, approval to drill the above referred to well is hereby granted in accordance with the General Rules and Regulations and Rules of Practice and Procedure. Said approval is, however, conditional upon the following:

1. A surveyor's plat of the proposed location is forwarded this office as soon as possible.
2. Should commercial production be encountered in this well, it shall not be produced from the same stratigraphic interval as the State #1 well, located in Section 5.
3. It is recommended that there be minimum disturbance to the environment in the area, due to the fact that this well is located in the same proximity as the Cedar Camp Ridge.
