





Gentlemen:

In reference to a telephone conversation this date with your Consultant, Mr. Dale Foutz, this letter is to advise you that this Division is withdrawing approval of the West #1 location pending the results of the re-entry of the Linney #1.

As each of these locations fall within the boundaries of the Order issued in Cause No. 102-5, they do not conform to the provisions of the Order; which states that a well may not be drilled less than 2640' from a producible gas well or 600' from a producible oil well.

Therefore, as there is a distance of approximately 655' between the Linney and the West #1, should the Linney be successfully completed as a gas well, this Division would terminate approval of the West #1. However, should the Linney be completed as an oil well, or plugged and abandoned, approval would again be granted to drill the West #1.


