Drill to Brushy Basin to test for commercial oil production, or will complete any commercial gas, as WK #2, 660' east did not complete in gas.

Hole to be drill with air as far as possible using Jacobs rotating head, Regan 7" torus BOP, Hydraulic closing unit - 6,000 PSI test, Casing spool - 6" 900 series 3,000PSI, Surface pipe and BOP will be tested to 800 PSI before drilling out from under surface. Baker, model G float valve at bit, String float at 1,200' depth.




