



Dear Mr. Driscoll:

You requested a letter explaining the reason for locating Mr. Paulsons Well 200 feet from the ~~1/4~~ line in Sec. 25.

Mr. Paulson wishes to locate the well in question as close as possible to the West boundary of his lease. Due to Cisco wash, he has had to locate the well 490 feet of the West line of his lease. The curve of the wash necessitates another 150 feet eastern movement in order to gain 100 feet northerly movement of the location. In other words, due to topography and erosion structures, we would have to move the well back to 2000 feet from east line in order to get it 1020 feet from north line. Mr. Paulson respectfully requests permission to locate the Paulson Well #25-1, 2150 feet FEL and 1120 feet FNL, Sec.25, T21S, R23E, SLB&M, Grand County, Utah.

If this is not permissible, please let us know, and we will move the location per your specification.

This well site was checked on the above date. A small workover unit and various other pieces of equipment were on location. It appears a completion attempt has been underway for quite some time. The gauges on the well-head were checked and there was no pressure on the tubing and the casing side indicated approximately 200 psig. A scorched bank was noted on a side of the reserve pit, and it appears that they had at one time flared gas from the well.





Records maintained by the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining indicate that you have failed to respond to numerous request for information on the Paulson 25-1 and Paulson 26-1 wells located in Grand County, Utah.

Be advised that if accurate information for the period June, 1981 through February, 1982 is not received by February 26, 1982, I shall schedule an Order to Show Cause before the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining. Among the measures I shall request the Board to approve is a moratorium of all your future drilling applications and operations.

Perhaps up to this point, you have not realized the serious possible consequences of your failure to comply with the Division's regulations. The situation is serious, and unwarranted. Furthermore, it will not be allowed to persist.

It is my wish that this matter be resolved without compelling you to appear before the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining. Therefore, if I can be of any assistance, please do not hesitate to contact me.
