Gentlemen:

I am enclosing two copies of Notice of Intention to Drill relating to a wildcat which I propose to drill in San Juan County, Utah. You will also find enclosed a Survey Plat prepared by San Juan Engineering.

You will note that this location falls off the established spacing regulations and I would therefore like to request an exception as shown on said Location Plat. The area to the south and to the east of the location is deeply cut by 30 to 50 feet deep gulleys separated by knife edge ridges. The location I have selected is the only accessible location in the subdivision. Mr. Jerry Long, USGS district engineer in Durango has approved the location and I am enclosing a letter from Husky Oil Company, the only lessee within 600 feet of the location, in which they agree to the exception.


I am attempting to meet a June 15 drilling commitment and it would therefore be appreciated if approval to drill could be received without delay.


