

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill a well on the above location to test the Mississippian and McCracken (Devonian) formations to a depth of approximately 9500'.


Surface casing will consist of approximately 1200' of 10-3/4" 32.75# and 40.5# H-40 cemented to surface.

Any gas or oil shows will be cored or tested and electric logs will be run. If commercial production is encountered, an engineered string of 7" or 5-1/2" casing will be run. If hole conditions dictate, it may be necessary to set intermediate casing through the salt zone and run a liner in the lower portion of the hole.

Anticipated spud date - September 1, 1960.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

Please be advised that approval to drill said well is hereby granted. However, said approval is conditional upon a plat being submitted as required by Rule C-4 of our General Rules and Regulations and Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Your attention is directed to our letter of July 29, 1960,

This letter is to advise you that, if in the future you should
desire to dually complete Well No. State 3 in the Devonian and
Mississippian formations, we would not be able to grant authority
to dually complete the well until such time as an order is issued
by the Commission on the Pure Oil Company application in Cause
No. 32.

Pure Oil Company has requested the Commission to establish 640-
acre drilling and spacing units covering the known producing (gas)
horizons of the Mississippi Lime in the Lisbon Field.

Gentlemen:

With reference to our telephone conversation of this date, please be advised that our approval to drill the above-mentioned well is hereby withdrawn. This action is necessary in the light of the Commission's determination that the largest spacing pattern or drilling unit requested in any particular spacing hearing should establish the spacing pattern until such time as the hearing has been held and an order issued establishing drilling units for any particular pool.

Elliot, Inc. and Pubco Petroleum have requested 160-acre drilling units for the McCracken formation. In view of these requests and the ruling of the commission, I am unable to approve a drilling location on less than 160 acres.
