

1. 8 5/8" O.D. 24 lb/ft surface will be run to approximately 500' and cemented back to ground level. ✓
2. 7 7/8" hole will be drilled below surface to T. D.
3. If commercial production is obtained 5 1/2" O.D. 15.50 lb/ft. casing will be run through all producing zones and cemented. ✓
4. Estimated depths of objective formations: Lower Ismay 5530-5600; Desert Creek 5630-5770.

The derrick floor and kelly bushing elevation will be furnished after the contractor moves on location.
