

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

To drill and test the Cane Creek member of the Paradox Salt. Surface Casing: 10-3/4' OD, 40.5# H-40 casing to be set at approximately 450' KB and cemented with 350 sax cement W/1/4 cu.ft. stratacrete/sack followed with 50 sax neat cement. Production Casing: 5-1/2' OD 14# & 15.5# J-55 to be set at approximately 6000'. Cement with 150 sax 50-50 Pozmix cement W/2% gel. Coring: None planned. Testing: Significant shows from samples or logs. Logging: Gamma Ray Neutron from surface to TD.

Note: In telephone conversation between British-American's E. E. McCurtain and Mr. Smith of the Utah Oil & Gas Conservation Commission on 2-23-62, the requirement of a certified plat showing the proposed well location was waived. However, no work of any kind will be done on this location until the location has been staked, the plat has been submitted and approved by both the U.S.G.S. and the Utah Oil & Gas Conservation Commission.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your notice of intention to drill Well No. USA #1, which is to be located 660 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 6, Township 27 South, Range 20 East, S1EM, San Juan County, Utah.


