DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Rotary drilling equipment will be used to drill to the Paradox SALT formation, with an estimated TH of 6000'. Surface formation: Morrison. Surface casing 600 to 2000' of 20-3/4" OD 32.75# & 40.5# annular casing, depending upon the presence or absence of a water flow, casing to be cemented to the surface. Production string: 7" 20 & 23# J55 or 5 1/2" 24 & 15# casing as available, to be cemented with required amount of cement. Mud program: Conventional and/or gyp or salt base mud as required. Drill stem tests: all oil or gas shows will be tested. Logs: Electric logs, etc. will be run before setting casing or abandonment. Will complete in open hole and/or perforate oil string as required. Stimulation treatments such as acid or hydraulic fracturing may be employed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
