Rotary drilling equipment will be used to drill approximately 5700', or to the Desert Creek formation. Surface casing - approximately 150' of 13-3/8" will be set and cemented to surface. Production string will be 4 1/2" or 5 1/2" OD, depending upon the amount and type of pay zone. All casing to be cemented with required amount of cement. Drill stem testing, allworthy shows of oil and gas to be tested. Mud program: gel type mud. Electrical logs will be run before setting casing, or abandoning. Stimulation treatments may be employed in completion, if necessary.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.






