



Dear Mr. Feight:

We are herewith attaching notices concerning the development of the Moncrief-Navajo "A" and "B" Leases, these leases being the NE/4 and the NW/4 of Section 3, respectively, of T-41-S, R-24-E, San Juan County, Utah, all located in the Greater Aneth Area. We would like to comment briefly on these locations as they are staked:

The San Juan River flows across these two leases. The river has a wide bed at this location and it comes on the lease at about the SE corner of the NE/4, flows north across the middle of the NE/4 and then turns west through about the center portion of the NW/4 of Section 3. In this locality the river bed is wide with a large swampy area and in some places has three channels with running water. The locations as staked are all within the 160' tolerance except "A" No. 2 and this well location at its regular location would be at the water's edge. These properties are included in the Ratherford Unit and the location of these wells have been discussed with the unit operator and it is believed that these locations are in the best interests of all concerned.

1. Navajo "A" No. 1 - This location is staked 2,110' from the north line and 1,980' from the west line of Section 3, thereby locating the well 130' south of the center of

the SW/4 of the NE/4. This location was moved 130' south in order to have sufficient room for the drilling equipment near this river bed location.

2. Navajo "A" No. 2 - This location is staked 820' from the north line and 820' from the east line of the NE of the NE/4 of Section 3. A regular location for this well at the center of the quarter section falls on the river bed, and the amended location will allow for a better location for drilling and completion, but it still is well out into the swampy flood plane which stands water.

3. Navajo "B" No. 1 - This location is staked 2,100' from the north line and 660' from the west line, which places it 160' south of the river bank where there will be ample space for drilling equipment.

4. Navajo "B" No. 2 - This well is staked at the center of the SE of the NW/4, or 1,980' from the north line and 1,980' from the west line of Section 3. This location was moved off pattern of the NE of the NW/4 since the location in the NE/4 of the NW/4 would be within 50' of the channel and 700' out in the low, swampy area comprising the river bed at this point. The unit operator and members of the Ratherford Unit have been polled and they are agreeable to this change in location.

We would appreciate your early attention and approval of these locations inasmuch as we are anxious to start development on these properties at an early date. These stakes are in place and if you have any questions regarding them or would like to look at them on the ground, I will be glad to have a man meet with you in the field.
