AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this 11th. day of November 1958, by George Wall, Hereinafter called the first party, and Charles McConkie, hereinafter called the second Party.

Witnesseth that the first party is owner of a well (dry hole) located in Uintah County, Utah at Sec. 21-58-23E, Salt Lake Mer., and the second party desires to pull the 7" O.D. casing and plug same for half of pipe recovered from said well and also to do all plugging at his expense according to the State and Government code of plugging.

IT IS THEREFORE, agreed as follows;  
That permission is hereby granted to the second party to pull said pipe from said well.

It is further agreed that the second parties will co-operate with the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Utah in the pulling and plugging of said well, and comply with the rules and regulations of the Dept. of Interior of Uintah County and the State of Utah in said work; and to hold the first party free and harmless from liability of any nature whatsoever.





**This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of December 10, 1958, regarding the abandonment of Equity Oil Company- Well No. 1, located in the C NE NW of Section 21, Township 5 South, Range 23 East, SLEM.**

**In accordance with the plan discussed with you on your visit here during the week of December 3, we are approving that program and enclosing a copy of the notice of intention to abandon prepared that day, and which has been filed by George Wall, land owner, and yourself as operator.**

**In case you are unable to pull any pipe, it will be satisfactory if you leave the hole full of heavy mud, as is now the case, and place a 5 sack plug at the surface with a regulation 4 inch marker in the top.**

**It is also requested that you notify this office in ample time for someone to witness this plugging work.**

Dear Mr. McConkie:

On December 15, 1958, approval was granted to you to pull any casing possible in the Equity Oil Company Well No. Wall 1, Sec. 21, T. 5 South, R. 23 East, Uintah County, and thereafter plug the well in accordance with Mr. Hauptman's letter of the same date.

As of this date we have received no information as to whether the work program set out in your notice of intention to pull or alter casing, dated December 3, 1958, was ever performed. If the well was plugged and abandoned, a "Subsequent Report of Pulling Casing & Abandonment" should have been filed with this office.

Our files on the E. S. Rich Wells No. 1 and 2, located in Sec. 36, T. 8 South, R. 16 East, SLEM, Duchesne County, contain an approval letter, dated December 15, 1958 and signed by Mr. Hauptman, granting permission to you to pull casing and plug said wells, also, upon submission of a Notice of Intention to Abandon. As we have no further information regarding abandonment of these two wells, we should like to know if the work was ever performed.

A reply and/or subsequent reports of abandonment concerning these three wells will be greatly appreciated.

In reply to your letter concerning Equity Oil Co. Well # 1 Sec. 21, T5S, R23E, Uintah County, It was my agreement with Mr. Huaptman that if there was any recoverable casing in this well that I would pull same and plug the well in accordance with State and Federal regulations, however I found the casing to be cemented in to the surface and therefore could not recover any.
