

Dear Mr. Feight:

I received your letter of January 15 recently.

I am enclosing log of Well No. 2, North Ouray Unit. This is a driller's log, and may not be accurate in detail, except the location of the gas sand. Since Gulf Oil Corp. had a geologist checking the formation, we depended on him to log and identify the siltstone and various sands below the gas sand, all of which were dry but had specks of dead oil. There were no shows of live oil any place - also no water in any of the sands.

Since the U.S.G.S. never asked me for a log, I assume they were furnished a copy by Bill Gillespie, Gulf geologist.

I spent about a month in the Salt Lake hospital under the care of Dr. A. M. Okelberry, orthopedic surgeon. He released me just before Christmas, when I returned to Vernal by ambulance, and was placed under the care of a local ^{dr} during my convalescence. X-rays taken a couple of days ago revealed satisfactory healing of both my hip and wrist. However, the doctor says it will be several weeks before I can walk on my leg.

I will let you know when I resume operations on Well No. 3.
