

### Proposed Actions :

Mapco Production Company plans to drill the 6-11D well, a 4880' oil test of various formations. At a pre-staking meeting on February 19, 1982 the well was moved to its present location on the submitted survey plat of the APD in order to allow sufficient spacing distance from the 4-11D well a nearby producing well recently completed. A new access road of about 600' length will be required. A pad 190' by 400' and an irregularly shaped reserve pit are described in the APD. Existing drainages would be rerouted around the pad to avoid potential runoff problems.

### Recommended Approval Conditions:

The operator agrees to accept and adhere to the following conditions in addition to the plans outlined in the APD:

1. BLM stipulation
2. Lease stipulation
3. Provide adequate logs for the identification of other minerals as requested in the Mineral Evaluation Report and Mining Report.

We had already been to a PER conference over this 6-11D well on February 19, 1982 and came back to ascertain the location and make any final changes while the Dirt Contractors were bidding the location.

Mapco had to move the original staking of 6-11D because of proximity to the  
4-11D well 2-11D is also quite close both of these were completed in 1981.  
Location is still about 4 miles upstream from the Green River and will not have  
near as severe a potential problem as 4-11D had when it was drilled. 4-11D has since  
been built up and completed for production and improved to avoid runoff problems.  
Mapco had it ready for a forthcoming company safety and operations inspection next week.



Dear Mr. Guynn:

On April 6, 1982, a joint onsite inspection was made of the above referenced well site locations and proposed access roads by people representing MAPCO Production, USGS, and the BLM. We feel that the surface use and operating plans are adequate with the following stipulations:


1. Construction and maintenance of roads, rehabilitation of disturbed areas, and construction of pipeline routes shall be in accordance with the surface use standards as set forth in the booklet, "Surface Operating Standards for Oil and Gas Exploration and Development."
2. The maximum width of access roads will be 30 feet total disturbed area. Turnouts will not be required and travelling off the right-of-way will not be allowed.
3. Topsoil will be stockpiled as addressed in the applicants 13 Point Plan. Our office recommends the top 6-10 inches of topsoil material be stockpiled.
4. The BLM will be notified at least 24 hours prior to any construction.
5. The BLM will be notified at least 24 hours prior to any rehabilitation.
6. A burn pit will not be constructed. There will be no burying of garbage or trash at the location. No trash will be thrown in the reserve pit. All trash must be contained and hauled to the nearest sanitary landfill.
7. All permanent (on site for six (6) months duration or longer) structures constructed or installed, including the pumpjack, shall be painted a flat, non-reflective, earth tone color to match Tnemec 23-08351 Mesa Brown Enduratone or an approved equal. All facilities shall be painted within 6 months of when the production facilities are put in place. Facilities that are required to comply with O.S.H.A. (Occupational Safety and Health Act) standards are excluded.

8. Reserve pits will be fenced with a wire mesh fence topped with at least one strand of barbed wire.
9. A muffler system will be installed on all pumping units.
10. As discussed at the joint onsite, the pad dimensions will be 190' x 350'.

An archaeological clearance has been conducted by Archaeological-Environmental Research Corporation of the proposed drill sites and access roads. No cultural materials were located on the surface of the survey areas.

The proposed activities do not jeopardize listed, threatened or endangered flora/fauna and their habitats.



# CHOKER MANIFOLD


