



ONSHORE ORDER NO. 1

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE & OPERATIONS PLAN

An onsite inspection was conducted for the proposed location on 4/26/01, which included the USF&WLS (U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service). It was determined that the proposed location, access road and pipeline ROW fell within the "Flood Plain Area" and operations are to be conducted as stated in the *Final Ouray Environmental Assessment*.

1. Existing Roads:

Refer to Topo Map A for directions to the location.

Refer to Topo Maps A and B for location of access roads within a 2-mile radius.

All existing roads will be maintained and kept in good repair during all drilling and completion operations associated with this well.

2. Planned Access Roads:

Refer to Topo Map B for the location of the proposed access road.

The upgraded and new portions of the access road will be crowned and ditched with a running surface of 18 feet and a maximum disturbed width of 30 feet. Appropriate water control will be installed to control erosion; culverts are to be installed as needed to improve natural water drainage.

The access road was centerline flagged during time of staking.

Surface disturbance and vehicular traffic will be limited to the approved location and approved access route. Any additional area needed will be approved in advance.

3. Location of Existing Wells Within a 1-Mile Radius:

Please refer to Topo Map C.

4. Location of Existing & Proposed Facilities:

The following guidelines will apply if the well is productive.

Production facilities will consist of a conventional wellhead and allocation gas metering. The wellhead controls will be elevated to allow for a continuous production during seasonal high water conditions, as stated in the *Final Ouray Environmental Assessment 2.1.3, Production Operations*.

All permanent (on-site six months or longer) above the ground structures constructed or

Installed will be painted a flat, non-reflective, earthtone color to match one of the standard environmental colors, as determined by the five state Rocky Mountain Inter-Agency Committee.

All facilities will be painted within six months of installation. Facilities required to comply with the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) will be excluded. The required color is Desert Brown, Munsell standard color number 10 YR 6/3.

Any necessary pits will be properly fenced to protect livestock and prevent wildlife entry.

Refer to Topo Map D for the placement of the pipeline lateral.

5. **Location and Type of Water Supply:**

Water for drilling purposes will be obtained from Dalbo Inc.'s underground well located in Ouray, Utah, Sec. 32, T4S, R3E, Water User Claim #43-8496, Application #53617.

Water will be hauled to location over the roads marked on Maps A and B.

No water well is to be drilled on this lease.

6. **Source of Construction Materials:**

Surface and subsoil materials in the immediate area will be utilized.

Any gravel will be obtained from a commercial source.

Construction will not occur during the period of April 1 – July 15, unless it is determined by the USF&WLS and the Bureau of Reclamation that the flooding forecast evaluation has changed for the current year; as stated in the Final Formal Sec. 7 Consultation, page 37, Item #8.

7. **Methods of Handling Waste Materials:**

Drill cuttings will be removed from the *Closed-Loop Circulating System* and transported by truck to an approved disposal site outside of the floodplain area. Please refer to "Typical Rig Layout" and the "Typical Solids Control System" attachments.

Drilling fluids, including salts and chemicals, will be contained in the *Closed-Loop System*. Upon termination of drilling and completion operations, the liquid contents will be removed and disposed of at an approved waste disposal facility after drilling is terminated.

The *Closed-Loop System* will be utilized and set-up in the area normally utilized for a reserve pit. Refer to the Location Layout.

Any spills of oil, gas, salt water, or other noxious fluids will be immediately cleaned up and removed to an approved disposal site.

A chemical porta-toilet will be furnished with the drilling rig.

Garbage, trash, and other waste materials will be collected in a portable, self-contained, fully enclosed trash cage during operations. No trash will be burned on location.

All debris and other waste material not contained in the trash cage will be cleaned up and removed from the location immediately after removal of the drilling rig.

No chemicals subject to reporting under SARA Title III (hazardous materials) in an amount greater than 10,000 pounds will be used, produced, stored, transported, or disposed of annually in association with the drilling of this well. Furthermore, no extremely hazardous substances, as defined in 40 CFR 355, in threshold planning quantities, will be used, produced, stored, transported, or disposed of in association with the drilling of this well.

Any produced water from the proposed well will be contained in a water tank and will then be hauled truck to one of the pre-approved disposal sites: RNI Sec.5,T9S,R22E; NBU #159, Sec.35, T9S, R21E; Ace Oilfield Sec. 2, T6S, R20E, MC&MC Sec.12, T6S, R19E,. (Requests in lieu of filing Form 3160-5 after initial production).

8. **Ancillary Facilities:**

None are anticipated.

9. **Well Site Layout:** (See Location Layout Diagram)

The location is at least 460' away from the river, thus meeting the requirements set forth by the USF&WLS.

Location size may change prior to the drilling of the well due to current rig availability. If the proposed location is not large enough to accommodate the drilling rig. The location will be re-surveyed and a form 3160-5 form will be submitted.

USF&WLS shall be notified within 48 hours prior to construction.

No reserve pit shall be utilized, as discussed during the on-site inspection.

Seasonal ditch on location to be restored after gravel is removed, as discussed during the on-site inspection with Mr. Mike Montoya.

The access road shall be constructed with tundra and topped-off with gravel, or composite mats will be used, as discussed during the on-site inspection.

Trees are to be avoided when possible if tree removal is necessary; Coastal will notify the AO with the tree count, and Coastal is to replace four trees for every tree removed.

10. **Plans for Reclamation of the Surface:**

Producing Location:

Immediately upon well completion, the location and surrounding area will be cleared of all unused tubing, materials, trash, and debris not required for production.

Immediately upon well completion, any hydrocarbons in the pit shall be removed in accordance with 43 CFR 3162.7-1.

Upon completion of backfilling, leveling, and recontouring, the stockpiled topsoil will be spread evenly over the reclaimed area(s).

Dry Hole/Abandoned Location:

Abandoned well sites, roads, and other disturbed areas will be restored as near as practical to their original condition. Where applicable, these conditions include the re-establishment of irrigation systems, the re-establishment of appropriate soil conditions, and re-establishment of vegetation as specified.

All disturbed surfaces will be recontoured to the approximate natural contours, with reclamation of the well pad and access road to be performed as soon as practical after final abandonment. Reseeding operations will be performed after completion of other reclamation operations.

All lease and/or unit operations will be conducted in such a manner that full compliance is made with all applicable laws, regulations, the approved Plan of Operations, and any applicable Notice of Lessees. The Operator is fully responsible for the actions of his subcontractors. A copy of these conditions will be furnished to the field representative to ensure compliance.

A qualified Archaeologist is to monitor all construction, as discussed at the on-site inspection.

The Operator will control noxious weeds along Rights-Of-Way for roads, pipelines, well sites, or other applicable facilities.

A Class III archaeological survey has been conducted. A copy of the survey report was submitted to the Ute Tribe Energy & Minerals Department prior to the onsite.






We have been advised of changes occurring with the operation of your database for Change of Operator. You will be modifying your records to reflect Change of Operator once you have received all necessary documentation from the companies involved, and perhaps in advance of our Notice of Concurrence/Approval of Change of Operator where Indian leases are involved.

We have no objection.

With further comment to Rulemaking, I wish to comment concerning the provision of Exhibits for upcoming Hearings. I would like to see the Uintah & Ouray Agency, BIA, and the Ute Indian Tribe, Energy & Mineral Resources Department added to the list of those parties that receive advance Exhibits so as to allow us to have research time prior to Hearing dates. We will be able to provide a more informed recommendation to the Oil, Gas and Mining Board. It would be best if we would receive only those Exhibits that concern Indian lands, specifically on or adjacent to Indian lands. This may be a difficult situation to attain, as it is not always clear where 'on or adjacent' occurs.

I am aware that you have gone to extra effort to correct this matter already, and I fully appreciate it. My request is intended only to allow the addition of Uintah & Ouray Agency and Ute Indian Tribe to the official listing.

We appreciate your concern, and hope that these comments are timely enough for consideration in the revision process.


