





Dear Mr. Stubbs:

On July 15, 1963, Judge C. Nelson Day of the 5th District Court signed a restraining order enjoining you from future drilling of the Well No. Four Boys-Federal #1, located in Township 43 South, Range 15 West, Washington County, Utah. You are also enjoined from removing any of the drilling equipment from the location. A hearing has been set for the 29th day of July, 1963 at the court house in St. George for the purpose of determining whether or not a permanent restraining order should be granted.

This Commission will request the court restrain any further drilling until such time as a bond has been filed with either this Commission or the United States Geological Survey, a survey plat furnished as required in Rule C-4, of our Rules and Regulations and a hearing held to determine whether you should be allowed to continue drilling this well off of the normal spacing pattern as provided for in Rule C-3 of the above mentioned rules and regulations.

Incidentally, I would suggest that you have this location surveyed in immediately as there is some question as to whether or not you have been drilling this well on a Mr. Seegmiller's property.

C O M P L A I N T

Civil No. 3186

1 . The plaintiff is a sovereign department and entity of the State of Utah, charged with the conservation of oil and gas within the State of Utah, and the regulation of drilling and other operations attendant to the proper conservation of oil and gas within the State of Utah.

2. The defendants have commenced to drill an oil and gas well for exploration or recovery purposes in Washington County, in the South Half of Township 42 South, Range 15 West, Washington County, State of Utah, and have done so without complying with Rule C-4 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Utah Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, in that they have failed to file a notice of intention to drill, and Rule C-1 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Utah State Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, in that they have failed to submit to the Commission an appropriate surety bond to cover the cost of plugging said well upon the completion of working operations.

3. That all of said derelictions above mentioned and actions of the defendants in drilling said well are contrary to Section 8 of the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, and that the present action is properly brought, pursuant to Section 9 of the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, being Title 40, Chapter 6, U.C.A. 1953.

4. That unless the defendants are restrained from further operating or drilling on the lands in question, and from removing their drilling rig so as to leave an unplugged hole, and unless they are further restrained and enjoined to comply with the rules and regulations of the Commission, the people of the State of Utah and the State of Utah will be irreparably harmed and injured.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays that the court:


1. Issue a temporary restraining order enjoining the defendants from (a) further drilling operations; (b) removing their drilling rig or otherwise leaving an unplugged hole.

2. That the court permanently enjoin the defendants from conducting any drilling operations on the above described lands and from removing their drilling equipment and rig, or otherwise leaving an unplugged hole.

3. That the defendants be enjoined, as provided in 1 and 2 above, until such time as they shall comply with the rules and regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.




