



I talked with Mr. George Morris, Attorney for Huroco, 4-18-62 concerning completion reports for Wells No. 13-13 and 24-13.

Mr. Morris forwarded our letter to Mr. R. A. Oles to obtain this information. Since Mr. Oles did not have this information available, he advised us to get in touch with the driller.

Mr. Morris will now try to contact Tim Ballard, Hurricane, and try to secure information concerning the status of these two wells.

MEMO FOR THE FILE:

I talked with Mr. George Morris, Attorney for Huroco, today concerning completion reports for Wells No. 13-13- and 24-13, as we have not received reports from these people since May, 1962.

According to Mr. Morris, these wells are still shut-in as no work has been done in that area lately. He doubts if logs were run, as both wells were drilled to a shallow depth. However, he said he would check into the matter and forward "status" reports as soon as possible.
