

In Re: Stipulation

Dear Sir:

Sagadahoc Oil & Gas Corporation is the owner of U. S. Oil and Gas Lease Utah - 4444, and proposes to drill a well on the leased premises to test for oil and gas at a location in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10, T. 30 S., R. 16 E., SLB&M Mer., Wayne County, State of Utah, 2819 feet from North line and 3604 ft. from East line of Section 10, T. 30 S., R. 16 E., SLB&M.

Section 221.20 of the Federal Oil & Gas Regulations requires that no well be drilled less than 200' from the boundary of any legal subdivision without the written consent of the Supervisor, U.S. Geological Survey. The proposed location is approximately 179 feet from the North boundary line of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, but is considered to be necessary because of inaccessable terrain in the center of the 1/4 section tract.

Therefore, Sagadahoc Oil & Gas Corporation, lessee, requests the consent of the Supervisor to the drilling of the proposed well at the above described location. In consideration of such consent, Sagadahoc Oil & Gas Corporation, lessee hereby expressly covenants and agrees that he will make no separate assignments of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10, T. 30 S., R. 16 E., SLB&M Mer., and that he will keep the two described subdivisions under joint assignment until the above mentioned well has been plugged and abandoned with the approval of the Supervisor.






I will attempt to answer your letter of December 18, 1978.

Our records indicate that the Federal #3 well, originally scheduled to be drilled in Section 10, T30S, R16E, Wayne County, Utah was not drilled. The Skyline State #1 well was drilled in Section 16 and plugged many years ago. I note that the Schlumberger ticket indicates that this well was the "Skyline State #3" and that it was drilled in Section 10, which surely must be an error.

All pertinent records pertaining to the drilling of the Sagadahoc Federal #1 and the Sagadahoc Federal #2 and the Skyline State #1, all in this same township and range, were made available to the State of Utah, and as I recall, Mr. Paul Burchell or a representative was there in the field when these three wells were drilled.

I hope that this helps clear up the confusion.
