

DOWNLOADING MULTIPLE WELL FILES

Downloading multiple files from the Windows Well Files Directory interface requires the use of a program such as Wget for Windows.

A free download for Wget (for Windows) is available at <http://gnuwin32.sourceforge.net/packages/wget.htm>.

We suggest you use the “Complete package, except sources” download option. We also suggest that you read the “Installation, Usage and Help” instructions. Additional information can be found at <http://www.gnu.org/software/wget/> and <http://www.gnu.org/software/wget/manual/wget.html> (manual for version 1.12).

Once installed, you should be able to execute the program from its installation location via the “Command Prompt” accessory on your computer. There are a lot of options available with this program, but a basic line of code such as this may get you much of what you need:

```
wget -r -l1 --no-parent -A.pdf http://fs.ogm.utah.gov/pub/Oil%26Gas/Well_Files/001/
```

NOTES:

- After “wget -r”, that’s an “l” (as in larry), followed by a “1” (one).
- The “001” will need to be replaced by whatever county you desire to download (e.g., 001 = Beaver County). See County Codes at http://oilgas.ogm.utah.gov/Data_Center/LiveData_Search/codes_lookup.cfm.
- Executing the program seems to be fairly case-sensitive, so if you type in “well_files” instead of “Well_Files”, it will probably fail.
