3. There will be no violation of correlative rights by the granting of said application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD THAT the application of Bowers Oil and Gas be granted allowing an exception to the provisions of the Order issued in Cause No. 102-16B so as to permit the drilling of a well 1633 feet from the South Line and 2232 feet from the East Line of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 21 East, SLBM, Grand County, Utah.




