NOW THEREFORE, the Board having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said Hearing, and being fully advised in the premises, now makes and enters the following:

Findings

1. Due and regular notice of the time, place and purpose of the Hearing was given to all interested parties in the form and manner and within the time required by law and the rules and regulations of the Board.
2. The Board has jurisdiction over the matter covered by said Notice and over all parties interested therein and has jurisdiction to make and promulgate the Order hereinafter set forth.
3. Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of the working interests under the Federal Oil and Gas Leases issued by the United States of America covering the following indicated lands situate in Uintah County, Utah, to-wit:

Township 7 South, Range 22 East, S.L.M.

Section 5: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 8: W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

(Containing, in all, 320 acres, more or less)

4. Said leased lands above described in the preceding paragraph comprise a drilling unit for the purpose of drilling a Uinta Formation test well in the approximate center of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

of said Section 5.

5. The Uinta Formation underlying the above described drilling unit consists of thin lenticular beds which make correlation from one well to another in the immediate area impossible.

6. The drilling of a well at the location described above will, in the event production is encountered, prevent economic waste and provide for the sufficient drainage of the drilling unit.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, THAT:

A. A three hundred and twenty (320) acre drilling unit be and the same is hereby established comprising the lands hereinabove described in Paragraph No. 3 for the development and production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from said Uinta Formation.

B. No more than one well shall be drilled on such unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from a common source of supply in said Uinta Formation and that the permitted well shall be located in the approximate center of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 5, Township 7 South, Range 22 East, S.L.M.


C. This Order shall be in effect until further order of this Board.

D. This Board retains continuing jurisdiction of all matters covered by this Order and all other applications and orders and over all parties affected thereby and particularly that the Board retains and reserves continuing jurisdiction to make further orders as appropriate and authorized by statute and

applicable regulations.


