Subject: Five Year E&P Waste Disposal Facility Permit Renewal and Full Cost Bonding

Disposal Facility Operators:

Per **R649-9-8.5.1 Bonding of Disposal Facilities**, waste disposal facilities require permit renewal and posting of full cost bond by July 1, 2018. The current permit to operate the waste disposal facility will expire July 1, 2018. **Failure to submit a complete permit renewal application and post full cost bond will result in the Division requiring facilities to cease operations at permit expiration on July 1, 2018.**

To ensure timely review of permit renewal applications and bond submissions, the Division recommends operators submit complete permit renewal applications by May 15, 2018. The Division has posted the following documents for operators use in submitting applications and full cost bonding on the Utah Oil & Gas Home Page, <https://oilgas.ogm.utah.gov> under the "Publications" tab "Handbooks & Guidance Documents":

All operators should complete and return the *Five Year E&P Waste Disposal Facility Bond Calculation Summary Form* to the Division as part of the permit renewal application.
