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This cause came on for hearing before a hearing examiner appointed by the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining at 8:30 a.m., on Tuesday, February 22, 1983, in Room 4110 of the State Office Building, Salt Lake City, Utah, pursuant to an Order to Show Cause any an exception to the wildcat well spacing pattern established by the Order issued in Cause No. 102-16B should not be allowed.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

(1) Due and regular notice of the time, place and purpose of the hearing was given to all interested parties in the form and manner and within the time required by law and the rules and regulations of the Board;

(2) No objections were received or appearances made entering objections to the application; and

(3) There will be no violation of correlative rights by the granting of said application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD THAT the application of Layton Oil & Gas Production Company be granted allowing an exception to the provisions of the Order issued in Cause No. 102-16B so as to permit:

(1) The drilling of Well No. 3-34, located 1720 feet FSL and 500 feet FEL, NE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 23 East, Grand County, Utah;


(2) The drilling of Well No. 2-35, located 500 feet FSL and 500 FWL, SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 23 East, Grand County, Utah; and

(3) The drilling of Well No. 3-35, located 1820 feet FSL and 500 feet FWL, NW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 23 East, Grand County, Utah.


