- (3) There will be no violation of correlative rights by the granting of said application.

Whitley be granted allowing an exception to the provisions of the Order issued in Cause No. 185-2 so as to permit the drilling of the KGS No. 1-25 well, 2000 feet from the North line and 1520 feet from the West line of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 22 East, SLM, San Juan County, Utah.




