NOW THEREFORE, the Board being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:


1. Due and regular notice of the time, place and purpose of the hearing was given to all interested parties in the form and manner and within the time required by law and the rules and regulations of the Board;
2. No objections were received or appearances made entering objections to the Application, and;
3. There will be no violation of correlative rights by the granting of said Application.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board that the Application of Burton Hawks, Inc. be granted allowing an exception to the provisions of Rule C-3, General Rules and Regulations so as to permit the drilling of a well in the SW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 28, Township 3 North, Range 8 East, S.L.M., Summit County, Utah, at a surface location 1356 feet from the North line, 400 feet from the West line with the proposed bottom hole location 1416 feet from the North line and 520 feet from the West line.




